As we reflect on 46 years of service, we are proud of the role United Way Fort McMurray and Wood Buffalo (UWFMWB) has played in building stronger communities in our region. Since our founding in 1978, we have raised over \$118 million, directly supporting social profit agencies and helping countless individuals and families thrive.

This past year alone, over \$2.8 million has been invested into 20 agencies across our region. These funds help provide essential services to individuals facing poverty, homelessness, addiction, and mental health challenges. Over 1 in 4 people in our community either use or know someone who uses services from our social profit agencies, making the need for support more urgent than ever.




Meet the Board
